In a span of three months in 2024, Andy won two Philadelphia jury trials defending cases alleging injuries sustained playing college football. In a span of eight months in 2022, Andy won three jury verdicts for his clients in patent trials held in Texas and Pennsylvania. Andy has tried numerous jury and non-jury trials to verdict in federal and state courts across the country, and he has led trial teams conducting arbitrations in Stockholm, London, Zurich, and the United States.

Andy's trial experience includes torts, patents, contracts, business torts, trade secrets, breach of fiduciary duty, corporate governance, shareholder disputes, trusts, professional liability, and civil rights. He has extensive experience representing technology-focused businesses, including software and systems, chemistry, chemical engineering, and mechanical engineering. On the appellate level, Andy has argued appeals before the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Third, Fourth, and Eleventh Circuits; the Pennsylvania Superior Court; the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court; and the California Court of Appeal.

From 1992 to 1993, Andy served as a law clerk for the Honorable Sam C. Pointer, Jr., Chief Judge of the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Alabama. During law school, Andy was the notes editor for the *Virginia Journal of International Law*.
