As a result of the reversal, his client was allowed to re-compete in a five-billion-dollar procurement.

Michael also assists government contractors and their investors in evaluating and

structuring mergers, acquisitions, and investments involving government contractors and government contracts. His experience includes small business program eligibility; due diligence; facility and personnel security matters; the mitigation of foreign ownership, control, and influence; and Anti-Assignment Act and novation matters.
