# Asian American Election Protection

## Volunteer Training Schedule - DC

In past elections, Asian Americans have faced a series of barriers in exercising their right to vote:

- Rude and hostile poll workers
- Too few interpreters to assist
- Missing translated voting materials

In response, AALDEF has conducted a non-partisan survey to document Asian American voting patterns and instances of anti-Asian voter disenfranchisement. AALDEF has also monitored the elections for compliance with the federal Voting Rights Act.

### Volunteers:

- Must attend one training session (no need for past volunteers)
- Must be non-partisan during their shift
- (Exit Poll) Administer a multilingual survey and document problems
- (Exit Poll) Work in 3-hour shifts between 7:00AM and 9:00PM
- (Poll Monitoring NY, NJ, MA, and PA only) Must be law students or lawyers
